Before you get too far along in your event planning, municipalities will need a firm handle on any required permits are necessary to ensure compliance and safety for attendees. The Engineer's Estimate base bid estimate was \$4,723,719.00; alternate bids totaling \$771,696.00; total plus all alternates of \$5,495,415.00.

Upon review of Dashiell Contracting's Bid Schedule we found a discrepancy in the figures for line 2b of the Base Bid.

- Bid Schedule stated: Qty of 10,575 x Unit Price of \$80.00 = \$1,246,000.
- Actual calculation: Qty of 10,575 x Unit Price of \$80.00 = \$846,000

When reaching out to the Contractor, in an email 2/7/2024 they stated "We work with the final prices adding everything together and then the computer has the formula to break it down to price per foot. When we changed the footage some how the formula was lost and didn't change the price per foot to the final price. So by our calculation it should be \$117.83 per foot to equal our final price of \$1,246,000.00. We apologize for our error"

Commonwealth has notified the Town's project Attorney of the above noted discrepancy and are awaiting his response.

Commonwealth Engineers, Inc. (Commonwealth) has worked with Dashiell Contracting, Inc. on past projects with great success. Additionally, several references listed by Dashiell Contracting, Inc. within the bidding documents have been contacted, and all were positive.

Therefore, it is the Engineer's recommendation; pending attorney review and coordination of project funding, that the Owner accept the low, responsive, responsible base bid from Dashiell Contracting, Inc. in the amount of \$2,671,217.77.

Three (3) bids were received and are summarized below, for your reference.

The Engineer's Estimate base bid estimate was \$2,319,844.00. Commonwealth Engineers, Inc. (Commonwealth) has worked with Caldwell Tanks, Inc. on past projects with great success. Additionally, several references listed by Caldwell Tanks, Inc within the bidding documents have been contacted, and all were positive.

Commonwealth noted during review of Caldwell's bid they indicated ongoing litigation / mitigation with one of their previous projects. We have notified the Town's project Attorney of such and indicated that we do not believe it is something that should be cause for concern. That said, we will ultimately defer to the Attorney's opinion on this matter.

Therefore, it is the Engineer's recommendation; pending review by the Town's Attorney and coordination of the project funding, that the Owner accept the low, responsive, responsible base bid from Caldwell Tanks, Inc. in the amount of \$2,637,000.00.

Original bid packages for Division "A" and Division "B" are attached for your records and use. The Owner should return the Bid Bonds from the non-winning proposals once the construction contracts with the low bidders have been executed.

It is our recommendation that tentative award be made to the aforementioned Contractors. Final award must wait until your financing is secured.


